**Public Policy Report**

**August 28, 2013**

I attended the Women's Equality Day program in Delray Beach on Monday evening. It was interesting, and well attended. Susan Bucher, Supervisor of Elections, spoke first, and focused on the Supreme Court decision earlier this summer to overturn parts of the Voters Rights Act, and its impact on states like Florida. She also spoke about the fact that Florida is one of the only states to completely and permanently disenfranchise convicted felons.

Mirya Holman spoke next about the "glass ceiling" and how few woman hold public office. Finally, Nancy Hurlbert spoke about women owned businesses and the Equal Pay for Women legislation as well as the violence against women legislation. It was an interesting program.
