Another one of our members, Nancy Albertz, recently tied the knot. Below is the low down straight from the Bride:

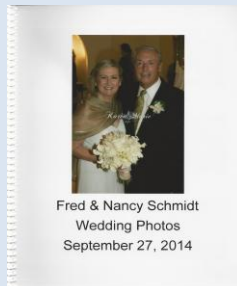
